SMALL CLAIMS PORTAL

A comparison of likely outcomes between using a solicitor and DIY with help from the Small Claims Portal for a claim worth £7,500

Summary:

- If you win using a solicitor you could recover as little as £1,060
- If you lose using a solicitor you could be out of pocket for £7,300
- If you win using DIY and the Small Claims Portal you could recover £6,720
- If you lose using DIY and the Small Claims Portal you would be out of pocket for £1,545

*The general rule is the successful party can only recover fixed costs in the small claims court. In this scenario, for using a solicitor it would be a total of £100. You can also recover the court fees, reasonable expenses, loss of earnings and experts fees. For the purposes of this illustration we will limit recovery to fixed costs and court fees.
